## EVENT REPORT OF DECLARATION CEREMONY OF TWO MULTI-DISCIPLINARY RESEARCH CENTERS

Indian Institute of Engineering Science and Technology (IIEST), Shibpur has declared the establishment of two multi-disciplinary research centers, viz; *1. Arun and Dhriti Deb Center of Water and Environmental Studies (ADDCWES)* and *2. Chirasree Center of Sustainable Infrastructure Development (CCSID)* with generous donations from two of its most illustrious alumni. The declaration took place on 29<sup>th</sup> March 2025, with the Hon'ble Minister Dr. Sukanta Majumdar, Minister of State, Ministry of Education, Government of India, as the Chief Guest. Dr. Majumdar emphasized the Institute's distinguished heritage and urged the IIEST community to collaborate through an interdisciplinary approach. encourage startups and entrepreneurial excellence.
