

## A Report on “Samvidhan Hatya Diwas” – 2025 observed by IEST, Shibpur on 25<sup>th</sup> June 2025

As per Office Memorandum No. M. 11014/03/2025 - CDN dt. 24th June, 2025 from the Department of Higher Education, MoE, Government of India, the **Samvidhan Hatya Diwas** was observed at the **IEST, Shibpur campus** on 25<sup>th</sup> June, 2025 under the Mentorship of Prof. V.M.S.R. Murthy, Director, IEST, Shibpur.

The Exhibition created by the Ministry of Culture was displayed and a short film produced by Mol&B was shown in outdoor LED screens throughout the day on 25<sup>th</sup> June 2025.



A programme of the students and other stakeholders on "SAMVIDHAN HATYA DIWAS" was organised on 25<sup>th</sup> June 2025 at the Alumni Seminar Hall of the Institute at 5.30 p.m. where significant number of faculty, staff members, students and research scholars attended. Prof. Sudipta Mukhopadhyay, Dean (Students' Welfare) delivered a inaugural address to the audience by highlighting the significance of this day. In his address, Prof. Mukhopadhyay elaborated on the historical background of the Emergency period in India, its implications on democracy, and the effects it had on the citizens and the constitutional framework.



Faculty members, employees and students shared their thoughts, reinforcing the relevance of the day and the lessons it imparts to present and future generations. Following the address, an Exhibition created by the Ministry of Culture was displayed and explained by Sri Deepak Kumar Singh, Research Scholar. A short film on emergency (Samvidhan Hatya Diwas), was also screened.

Cash prize amounts of Rs 800/- (Eight Hundred) and 500/- (Five Hundred) were awarded to the participants who stood 1st and 2nd position in the debate respectively.
