**NOTICE**

This is for information to all concerned that the Undergraduate (UG) students admitted in the academic session 2016-17 or after are eligible for full/partial tuition fee waiver provided their total family income does not exceed Rs. 5 Lakh in the last Financial Year, i.e. 2019-20. In view of that, applications are further invited from the 3<sup>rd</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> Semester students who could not submit their Family Income Certificate till 15<sup>th</sup> December as per Notification No. **DSW/Int. 29/20, Dated November 25, 2020**, due to any specific reason. The students, who joined 1<sup>st</sup> Semester UG Courses in November, 2020 but could not submit their Family Income Certificate till date may also apply. For this purpose, the concerned students must use the link ([https:// t.ly/WrF4](https://t.ly/WrF4)) of the Google Form to fill the requisite information and upload their Family Income Certificate (PDF), issued for the period 1<sup>st</sup> April 2019 to 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2020.
