At the outset Prof. Parthasarathi Chakrabarti, Director and Chairperson of this meeting of the BoG (as per clause 17 (15) of the Statutes of the Institute welcomed the members present in the meeting.

The Director informed the Board that with respect to the Writ Petition no 26616 (w) of 2015 (Basudeb Aich Vs The State of West Bengal & Ors) and W.P. No 26951(w)/2015(Madan Gopal Mukherjee Vs Government of West Bengal &ors.), the Hon'ble Kolkata High Court, on 20th November, 2019, has directed the Board of Governors of the IIEST to hold a meeting within the next four weeks and take a decision in the matter after they elect a Chairman as they may deem fit on the petitioner's grievance.

Since Dr. V. K. Aatre, the Chairperson, BoG is out of the country till the first week of January, a discussion was held on the issue through Skype on 28th November, 2019, wherein it was noted that the Director of the Institute can discharge the functions assigned to the Chairperson of the BOG in absence of Chairperson as mentioned in the Provision 17(15) of the Statutes of the Institute. With permission of the Chairperson and after consultation with MHRD, it was decided to convene a Board meeting on 17th December, 2019 in compliance with the directive of the Kolkata High Court.

Thereafter, the Chairperson requested the Registrar to place the item-wise agenda before the members for discussion.

As per the directive of the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta dt. 25.09.2019 regarding W.P. 26616(W) of 2015 filed by Shri Basudev Aich with W.P. No. 26951(W) of 2015, the BoG discussed the matter in its 15th meeting held on 17.12.2019 and examined all the available documents including Government Orders and Reasoned Order of MHRD already submitted by the Institute to the Hon'ble High Court. After detailed discussions, the BoG resolved that the relaxation of qualification to enable the petitioner to formally fit with the existing grade in which they are drawing salaries and emoluments, and which has already been turned down by the Government of West Bengal, cannot be extended to the petitioners.

The BoG further resolved that as the Reasoned Order is to be submitted to Hon'ble High Court on 19.12.2019, the resolution be considered confirmed and necessary action be taken up.
