NOTIFICATION

The Indian Meteorological Department, Ministry of Earth Sciences, Government of India through the press release dated 19.05.2020 has informed that the Super Cyclone, Amphan a very intense cyclone with associated wind speed of 200-210 kmph is expected to cross West Bengal-Bangladesh coasts between Digha and Haitya island close to Sundarban during afternoon to evening of 20th May 2020. It has an extensive damage potential which may also affect Howrah district severely. Keeping the above in view the following advisory is issued in the interest of the campus community.

- (a) Don't leave sharp object loose.
- (b) Switch off electrical mains, gas supply during the high wind.
- (c) Keep doors and windows shut before the high wind.
- (d) Remain indoor and don't venture out during the heavy rain/wind.
- (e) Do not park any vehicle near any tree or structure vulnerable to strong wind.
- (f) Watch out for broken electric poles, wires, other sharp objects after high wind.
- (g) All the doors and windows of Halls/Hostels should be secured properly.
- (h) Keep torches / candle lights readily available
- (i) Do not come close to any building/structure like unused Garage block quarters and Barrack type quarters already declared condemned by the Institute.
- (j) Students residing in the hostels should not go out of the hostel from tomorrow afternoon till the cyclone is ended.
