## 4.2. GATE 2025 Test Papers

GATE 2025 will be conducted for **30 test papers (subjects)**. Table 4 shows the list of test papers and codes for GATE 2025. A candidate is allowed to appear in ONE or TWO test papers. However, the combination of two test papers must be chosen from the list given in **Table 5**. Also note that for a paper conducted in multiple sessions, a candidate will be mapped to appear for the examination in one of the sessions ONLY.
