The Hon'ble Minister was impressed about the current initiatives of the Institute being implemented such as NEP based curriculum for holistic development of students, Master Plan, Infrastructure Development Plans for meeting the needs of the current generation, Product Development and Entrepreneurship, Clean and Green campus, under the leadership of the Director of the Institute and overall guidance of Chairperson. He advised for enhanced industry connect considering the location and also urged to focus on sectors namely, energy, manufacturing, health, and logistics including skill and community development. He further stressed on the following points:

- Institute first must come out of project mode and then apply for suitable HEFA Loan for building new infrastructure. Appreciated the plans for building new infrastructure.
- Considering the historical legacy of old infrastructure, efforts must be made to rejuvenate and repurpose them for sustained use.
- A master plan must be prepared envisaging the future needs of students keeping sustainable development goals in mind.
- Institute must make efforts to enhance the IRG close to 100 cr in the next two to three years
- Different avenues must be explored such as Centres of Excellence, high value R&D, Consultancy, EDP and Testing Projects. An inter-disciplinary mode must be encouraged.
