The Chairman welcomed the members and invitees present and also specially welcomed the new members of the Senate. The Chairman first explained the reason for calling this emergency meeting of the Senate and then opened the floor for discussion on the agenda item. The Chairman opined that members of the Senate should unanimously decide upon the matter so that advertisement process for PhD. Admission can be initiated. The Chairman requested Dean (Academic) to explain the agenda before the members.

Item EM6.1: To consider the recommendations of the 13<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Senate Standing Committee held on 27<sup>th</sup> March, 2019 regarding Admission to PhD programme: (July Cycle) 2019-2020.

## Resolution No. EM6.1:

The Senate discussed in details various aspects of the proceedings of Ph.D. admission Committee and resolved that to accept the admission brochure with suggested changes and as per the following guidelines:

1. Total number of Institute fellowship to be advertised for July 2019 cycle is 100. The School of Management Sciences and the School of Ecology, Infrastructure and Human Settlement Management will not be provided any Institute Fellowship in this cycle. Category-wise Institute fellow working in various Departments should be thoroughly checked and Seat Matrix be revised.



- 2. Age limit for 'Regular Candidates with Institute fellowship' should be 28 years for OC/EWS/OBC(NCL) categories. For SC/ST/Persons with Disability (PwD) and female applicants' upper age limit is relaxed by 05 years. There is no upper age limit for other categories of admission to Ph.D. Program.
- 3. Applications will be through ONLINE mode only and application fee is Rs. 1500.00 for OC/OBC(NCL)/EWS and Rs. 1000.00 for SC/ST/PwD candidates.
- 4. A valid GATE/NET score is essential for the applicants who are seeking admission in the 'Regular Candidates with Institute fellowship'. It is mandatory for the applicants to have been admitted to the preceding M.Tech. program through GATE only for all disciplines of Engineering, Technology and Architecture, Town & Regional Planning.
- 5. For admission under 'Sponsored Candidates' category: B.Tech. / B.E. candidate having 10 years or more experience in the reputed industry with R&D facility should have at least 60% marks or 6.5 CGPA on the scale of 10 throughout her/his academic career and those having more than 06 years and less than 10 years experience in the reputed industry with R&D facility and having at least 70% marks or 7.5 CGPA on the scale of 10 throughout her/his academic career.
- 6. Syllabus for written test: In general, the syllabus for the Engineering, Technology, Architecture, Town and Regional Planning Departments will be the same as of the GATE syllabus for the respective Departments. For Science and Humanities & Social Science Departments, the syllabus will remain same as the NET syllabus for the respective Departments.
- 7. Shortlisted regular candidates with Institute Fellowship category, after written (screening) test will be called for the interview department-wise. Final list will be published based on the performance in the interview.
- 8. Another Four fellowships (OC: 03, OBC:01) will be available from Ministry of New and Renewable Energy (MNRE). Govt. Of Inida find. Their eligibility criteria will be as that of Regular Candidates with Institute Fellowship. The Institute will not provide any assistantship/ fellowship to such a research scholar.
