A detailed report of the newly appointed faculty members as approved by the earlier Chairperson, BoG after an online emeeting held on 11.08.2023 was placed in the meeting. The BoG ratified the decision of the Chairperson, BoG. Further BoG resolved that new recruited faculty members who were in government service and applied through proper channel and are eligible for pay protection as per rule of the government, their pay will be protected as per rules of the Institute. The present age of retirement on superannuation of all Librarians in Centrally Funded Technical Institutions (CFTIs) is at 62 years subject to their possessing the qualifications and experiences as prescribed by UGC from time to time.

As per office memorandum F.No. 23-1/2008- TS.II dated 16.09.2009 issued by MHRD. Govt. of India, the age of superannuation of all Librarians including Assistant Librarian, etc. (as clarified vide O.M. F. 5-3/2012.TS-III dated 31.01.2013) was fixed at 62 years. The referred memorandum has not yet been adopted for IIEST, Shibpur unlike other CFTIs.

As the age of superannuation is not mentioned in the Recruitment Rules (2019) in NITs, the memorandum is placed for adoption and the Board resolved as per opinion of the Ministry representative that the matter will be send to the Ministry for adoption.
