The Chairman welcomed the members and the invitees present in the online emergency meeting. With the permission of the Chair, the Registrar (Acting) placed the agenda items before the Senate one by one for discussion.

Item EM.20.1: To take a stock of the effects on academics due to sudden rise in COVID-19 situation

Resolution EM.20.1:

In the beginning, the Chairman articulated his deep concern about the current critical situation arose due to the high surge of COVID-19 infection in the entire country. Several teachers, officers, staff, students, and their family members have been affected by this disease. He expressed that it is unknown how long this difficult period will continue. However, he further stated that amid the pandemic situation we shall

have to keep our academic activities continued. Thereafter, Dean (Academic) informed the members that a specific proposal came from the Head, Electrical Engineering Department to make a temporary pause for the academic activities till the situation improves. However, he stressed that if the current online academic activities are kept in abeyance for some time that may affect the Academic Schedule of AY 2020-21 which is already running late compared to that of the previous year. The next semester which is supposed to start from 09.08.2021 will be delayed further. Also the students who are already selected for internship at various places may not be able to attend. Problems may occur for the final semester students in joining in job.

The members discussed the issue in detail. Though the concern about current pandemic situation and the unknown future were strongly expressed, they mostly agreed to continue the academic activities as per schedule.

It was resolved that academic activities including the mid- term examination of PG(2nd/4th Semester) & DD(8th /10th Semester) Courses as well as the final examination of 4th/6th/8th semester UG programme shall continue as per the already declared Academic Calendar and the current semester for the above UG students shall end on 06.06.2021 completing all evaluation requirements. However, for the B.Arch. programme the evaluation process for the practical / sessional subjects may continue for one more week. It was further resolved that if any UG student cannot attend the final examination for medical ground, he / she shall intimate the authority, and decision for further examination shall be taken by the Senate based on the recommendation of the DUGC & SUGC depending on the merit. If any PG students fail to appear in mid-term examination, appropriate action shall be taken as per provision under the ordinances for the post graduate programs. The Senate also resolved to initiate necessary actions because of the urgency pending the confirmation of the minutes in the forth coming regular meeting of the Senate.
