**Item No.30.03** To consider the nomination of the Chairperson and the Senate nominee of the SUGC.

**Resolution:** Prof. Anirban Gupta, Professor, Civil Engineering Department and Prof. Aparajita Sengupta, Professor, Electrical Engineering Department were nominated as the Chairperson and Senate Nominee of the SUGC respectively. As per the provisions in the UG Ordinance their tenure shall be for two years from the date of notification. The Registrar shall take necessary action accordingly.

**Item No.30.04** To consider the nomination of the Chairperson and the Senate nominee of the SPGC.

**Resolution:** Prof. Hafizur Rahaman, Professor, Information Technology Department and Prof. Sudip Kumar Chattopadhyay, Professor, Chemistry Department were nominated as the Chairperson and Senate Nominee of the SPGC respectively. As per the provisions in the PG and Ph.D. Ordinances their tenure shall be for two years from the date of notification. The Registrar shall take necessary action accordingly.

**Item No.30.05** To consider the guideline for conversion from JRF to SRF of the Scholars enrolled under Ordinance.

**Resolution:** The Senate in its 10<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 07.02.2017 approved the guideline for selection of Junior Research Fellow (JRF) to Senior Research Fellow (SRF) holding Institute Scholarship. The guideline was issued by the Order No. RMS/5807/17 dt 24.03.2021. However, the revised guideline may now be necessary for the scholars who have joined under the new PhD Ordinance.

**Following guideline was finalized**

1. Essential Requirements
  - A. Completion of two years after date of enrolment
  - B. Registration completed
  - C. Obtained not more than one 'X' grade in thesis credit in the previous semesters after fulfilling the above two requirements.
  - D. Satisfactory performance before the Assessment Committee
2. On acquiring the first three essential requirements (as stipulated in (A, B & C), RPEC shall constitute a Performance Assessment Committee (PAC) comprising Chairman RPEC, Co-supervisor (if any), two faculty members in the relevant field of expertise with preferably one from the department and another from some other department of the Institute. In case of non-availability of expert within the Institute, one faculty member of any Institute of Repute may be nominated. Chairman RPEC shall chair the Committee. RPEC shall report details of the Committee to the Chairman DPGC.
3. After reporting to Chairman, DPGC; the Chairman RPEC shall arrange a meeting of the Committee in which the scholar shall present his/her research progress. Based on the performance of the scholar, the PAC shall send necessary recommendation to the Chairman SPGC through the Chairman DPGC.
4. The date of commencement of SRF position shall be the next date after two years from the date of enrolment.
5. After recommending the report of the PAC and mentioning the date of commencement of SRF position, the Chairman SPGC shall forward the report to the Director for consideration.
6. On receiving the approval of the Director, the Deputy Registrar (Academic) shall issue necessary order.
7. If any scholar acquires more than one "X" grade, his/her case shall be considered after one semester.
8. Upon fulfilment of first three essential requirements, at any stage if the Scholar is found not suitable to promote to SRF by any authority, the assessment shall be held after one semester.



9. The date of effect of SRF for the above two cases shall be decided by the Chairman SPGC. Also for any special condition, SPGC shall decide any other date for commencement of SRF position.

**Item No.30.06** To consider the recommendation of SUGC on conversion of supplementary examination to special examination for same students.

**Resolution:** On the recommendation of SUGC for the following students who did not appear the end semester examinations/supplementary examinations due to various reasons or result was withheld due to some reason, and considering the subsequent note of Dean (Academic) for allowing them to appear in the Supplementary Examinations. It was resolved that the supplementary examination of the following students in the mentioned subjects shall be considered as Special Examination as a special case in view of the pandemic condition.

It was further resolved that any other current student who was earlier awarded supplementary, his/her examination shall be converted to Special Examination for similar cases. The Academic Section shall propose the names of such students to the Chairman SUGC for approval.

**Item No.30.07** To consider and finalize the date, modality and other details of the 8<sup>th</sup> Annual Convocation.

**Resolution:** It has been decided that the eighth Annual Convocation of the Institute shall be held on December 23, 2021. The modalities and other details shall be decided by the committee to be constituted for this purposed subject to the approval of the Chairman-Senate.

**Item No.30.08** To consider the issues with regard to conducting supplementary examination of practical subjects under UG/PG ordinances.

**Resolution:** It was resolved that as per the provisions in the Ordinances, a student shall be awarded 'DR' grade if he/she fails to attend adequate number classes in practical subjects. The student shall be required to register for Summer Term in that case. If any student is awarded 'F' or 'I' grade in any practical subject there shall be supplementary examination for that student. In this particular year due to pandemic condition no summer vacation could be provided to the 1st year students. Therefore, for the present 3rd semester students the departments may arrange some special practical classes for those students who did not attend classes in the 1st year and after taking examination the grade shall be sent to the Academic section within the current semester.

**Item No.30.09** To consider the issues with regard to the award of the grade to the scholars attended NPTEL courses examination in online mode.

**Resolution:** NPTEL courses (PG level, 12 weeks duration) can be taken by the PhD students for credit transfer as per the PhD Ordinance and Regulations. NPTEL courses offered during January-April 2021 are taken by several PhD enrolled students of IESTS. Because of the restrictions imposed due to covid19 pandemic, the proctored final examination (physical mode) could not be conducted by NPTEL. Neither any online examination was also conducted. Modified certificates have been issued by NPTEL based on continuous online assessment (assignment) score and the certificates indicate that the modified certificate is applicable only for the students graduating in 2021 (attached). In response to a query by the SPOC, NPTEL for IEST, Shibpur, the NPTEL office has informed that *the validity of the certificate has to be decided by the institute. The institute can decide to accept the modified pass certificate towards credit or, if the institute wants to accept only the in-person results as valid towards credit, they can decide so. The decision rests with the institute* (attached). Considering the exigency, PhD scholars, who submitted their modified pass certificate through RPEC and DPGC, were permitted to complete the other formalities like comprehensive examination, state of the art seminar, to be eligible for registration to the PhD programme. Later on, proctored final examination (physical mode) for all pending examination of the NPTEL courses, offered during January-April 2021, have been conducted on August 8, 22 and 23. The results based on continuous assessment (30%) and proctored examinations (70%) have been published. Grade of the PhD scholars may be awarded either based on final score (assignment and proctored examination conducted in August 2021) or the earlier scores available in the modified pass certificate (based on assignments only). *The matter has been discussed elaborately in the Senate and resolved that SPGC shall examine the issue and place a specific proposal to the Chairman Senate.*

**Item No.30.10** To consider the application of Ms. Rajashi Sengupta Mothey, Ph.D. Scholar, Department of Humanities and Social Sciences.

**Resolution:** Ms. Rajashi Sengupta Mothey was enrolled on 17-07-2017 in the department of

Humanities and Social Sciences. Due to illness she could not appear for the Pre-Registration seminar due on September 2018. Initially she made a long delay to appraise the Department about her illness and also her willingness to continue PhD study. It has been resolved that application of the scholar be rejected and she may be advised to apply fresh by the concerned Head.

**Item No.30.11** To consider the proposal to accord post-facto approval for registering the thesis credit to some scholars enrolled under New Ordinance.

**Resolution:** Resolved that post-factor approval for thesis credit shall be accorded by the Chairman SPGC as a one-time measure to the scholars submitting necessary details 31st October, 2021. No post-facto approval shall be granted thereafter.

**Item No.30.12** To consider the matter related to MoU between Missouri University of Science and Technology (MST), USA and IEST, Shibpur.

**Resolution :**In the 28th Senate Meeting of the Institute, the matter related to the MoU between IEST, Shibpur and Missouri University of Science and Technology, USA, (MST) was placed (agenda item 28.10) for consideration.

It was noted that the IPR clause was missing in the document and the senate resolved that IEST, Shibpur shall communicate with MST for necessary changes. Subsequently, MST was contacted and they have sent the draft from their end (attached) and it is exactly the same that was proposed by IEST, Shibpur which includes the Intellectual Property clause also.


The MoU document was put up for consideration by the senate. *The Senate approved the draft MoU.*

**Item No.30.13** To consider the framing of modalities and a policy with regard to the attachment of interested faculty members of other academic units of the Institute to School of Mechatronics and Robotics (SoMR).

**Resolution:** A proposal for associating interested faculty members of different academic units to SoMR was submitted and the same was approved in principle by the Director. Subsequently, SoMR also proposed certain modalities for the implementation of the same. As per the note of the Dean (FW), this may also be considered for other schools/centres.

In the light of this proposal, resolved that the Dean (FW) shall notify to submit willingness of interested faculties from different academic units to be associated with any other Schools/Centres/Departments of his/her choice while serving one's own academic unit.

**Item No.30.14** To consider the list of external members of BoAC, Department of Mathematics.



**Resolution:** The list of BoAC members of the Department of Mathematics has been prepared by the DFC. As per PG/Ph.D. Ordinance, the Senate is authorized for approval of the names of the external members of the BoAC. It was placed before the Director and Chairman- Senate for Consideration. The Senate approved the names of the proposed external members.

**Item No.30.15** To report the approval of The Chairman, Senate for extension of registration of following three Scholars by one month beyond seven years considering the delay in submission due to pandemic situation.

- i) Ms.Arпита Roy, Department of Mining Engineering
- ii) Ms. Ankita Mukherjee, Department of Mining Engineering
- iii) Mr. Atanu Chatterjee, Department of Mining Engineering

**Resolution:** Prof. Pratik Dutta, Professor, Mining Engineering Department and supervisors of following three Scholars have submitted that due to considerable amount of constraints faced by him in checking the draft of the dissertations during lockdown period, the scholars could not submit the thesis within 7 years after registration. The Doctoral Committees of these three Scholars and the DPGC recommended for extension of registration by one month for each Scholar. Chairman SPGC also endorsed the same recommendation.

- ii) Ms. Ankita Mukherjee From 13/08/2021 to 13/09/2021
- iii) Mr. Atanu Chatterjee From 27/08/2021 to 27/09/2021

The Director approved the one month extension beyond 7 years and directed to report it in the next meeting of the Senate. The Senate ratified the approval of the Chairman, Senate.

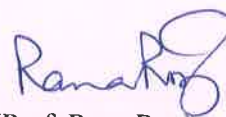

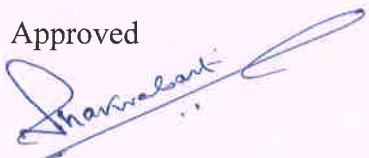
